Dear Parent/Caregiver

Student Services have organised 2 reward activities for students to positively end 2019. These reward days are part of our Positive Behaviour in Schools program, which aims to promote good attendance and positive behaviour. As a school we have been able to absorb the cost of these activities. Any parents who have already paid for the activities will receive a full refund.

### 1. KULIN WATER SLIDE

This activity is open to all students who have maintained their Good Standing. There are 50 places available for this excursion. Year 10 students will be given first preference and students from all other year groups will be considered based on a "first in best dressed" process. All participants must have successfully completed Stage 7 Swimming to be eligible for this excursion.

**When and Where:** Departing Narrogin SHS at 9.00am Thursday 19 December  
Arrive at Kulin Water Slide approximately 10.30 am

Depart Kulin Water Slide at 1.30 pm  
Return to Narrogin SHS at 3.00 pm

**Cost:** There is no cost for this excursion

**What to wear:** Sun-smart casual dress.

**What to bring:**

- Bathers, towel, hat, sunscreen.
- Lunch (sausage sizzle will be provided however students may take their own lunch. No other food is available for purchase at the venue).
- Participants **must have successfully completed Stage 7 Swimming** to enter the water-based rides or swimming pools.

**What to wear:** Students are asked to wear a plain T-shirt in their Form colour or a school shirt and shorts. **Sports shoes** are the only appropriate footwear


